To: Thailand Securities Depository Co., Ltd. (TSD) participants

Re: Dividend payment in foreign currency for foreign investors

TSD would like to inform participants that dividend payments can now be made in a designated foreign currency to foreign investors having securities in TSD's depository system. These investors should relay their currency preference to their brokers/custodians (TSD participants). Participants should then program the depository system (PTI) to make the appropriate payment by clicking on: *Menu Depository -> Shareholder*. Choose Check for payment of dividend/interest and finally identify the foreign currency from the list below:

1. Euro : EUR
2. Hong Kong Dollar : HKD
3. Pound Sterling : GBP
4. Singapore Dollar : SGD
5. US Dollar : USD
6. Yen : JPY

Participants must submit the required information to the depository system before the listed company book-closing date in order to have dividend payments be in a foreign currency.

Payment in the designated currency will cover all securities, including NVDRs, for which TSD has been the registrar for dividend payment from January 15, 2008 onwards until participants authorize a subsequent change of currency.
